In the name of God, Amen I Paulus Jones of the County of Buckingham, and State of Virginia do make this my last Will and Testament.

1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Judy Ann Jones and my six youngest children namely: Isella, Mary Susan, Ellen, Harrison, Henry and Raymons all of my team consisting of three horses and one mule upon this condition that if my three sons Morton, Anderson and Reuben choose to work said team and give to my said wife, and six children one half of all the crops raised on hires for said team they are at liberty to do so, but should Morton, Anderson and Reuben decline to work my team as I have indicated, then I leave it with my wife to employ any one she may think proper to carry out in regard to working said team and upon such terms as she and they may agree upon.

2nd It is my desire as soon as my youngest child arrives at the age of twenty one year that all my property shall be equally divided amongst all my children.

At a County Court held for Buckingham County, April 12th 1875. This paper was
brought forward to be the last Will and Testament of Paul Jones, dec^d was this day
produced in Court and proved by the oaths of P. A. Forbes and Arthur Manley,
the subscribing witnesses thereto, and ordered to be recorded. and there being no
opponent named in said Will, and Judy Ann Jones, widow of testator, declining
to qualify as Administratrix on the motion of Peter A. Forbes, who made
oath to said Will and with John C. Turner and Garland B. Namer, his security,
entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$1000. conditioned ac-
cording to law, (executions sworn to justify) certificate is granted the said
Peter A. Forbes for obtaining Letters of Administration on the said decedent's
estate, with his Will aforesaid annexed in due form.

In the presence of witnesses I Charles M. Banton of the County of Buckingham
and State of Virginia, being in full health but of sound mind make this my last Will
and Testament as follows

Clause 1 I give and bequeath to my wife Paulina A. Banton after paying
all my just debts all of my landed estate also all stock cattle and farming
utensils &c on the place I now reside so long as she may live my main object
is to make my widow comfortable, after my death I desire my property disposed
of as follows provided my children are kind watchful and affectionate to their
mother that on my death I leave
