recorded. And there being no Executor named in said Will, on the motion of
Wm A. Jones, Letters of Administration with the said Will annexed, on the estate of

by law, and with Joseph E. Morgan, his security entered into, and acknowl-
edged as bond in the penalty of \$150. conditioned according to law. Security
