bed and clothing for same suitable and one Bureau, and to Lewis J.  
Andrew Floyd and Thomas J. Goolsby one bed and covering each.  
I desire that the rest of my children not named above who have  
never received a bed from me be also given one each. The balance  
of my property not disposed of above, that I may have at my death  
it want it equally divided among the remaining children that
