The real estate hereby bequeathed being the same devised to me under the Will of my mother Grace P Austin and at my death is by her said Will devised to my children.

I hereby appoint Frank Wade and Eveline Wade (his wife) Executor and Executrix of this my last Will and Testament, and it is my wish that they be allowed to qualify without giving security.

At a County Court held for Buckingham County, February 8th 1886. This paper writing purporting to be the last Will and Testament of Thomas Austin dec^d, was this day produced in Court and thereupon W^m M. Cabell and F. A. Forbes were sworn who testified that they are well acquainted with the testator's handwriting, and verily believe the said writing and the name thereto subscribed to be wholly written by the testator's own hands whereupon the said writing is ordered to be recorded as the true last Will and Testament of the said Thomas Austin dec^d, and on the motion of Frank Wade, the Executor named in said Will, who made oath thereto, and

entered into and acknowledges a bond in the penalty of \$60.00 with
 out security, the testator by his Will directing that none should be
 required, certificate is granted the said Executor for obtaining a probate
 of the said Will in due form.

4th I do hereby appoint Henry Winn as my Administrator
 to carry out the provisions of this my last Will according to law.

5th In case my daughter Fannie Gertrude Agee should die
 without heirs, I desire my estate to go to my other living children
 or their heirs. Witness my signature this 12th day of April 1881.
