At a Court held for Buckingham County, July 8th 1869. This paper purporting to be the last will and testament of Thomas H Perkins, was this day produced in Court, and there being no subscribing witnesses thereto, Re B Shaw Jr and John S Tompkins were sworn, who testified that they are well acquainted with the hand writing of the testator, and that they verily believe the said writing, and the name thereto subscribed to have been wholly written by the testator own hand, and thereupon the said will is ordered to be recorded: and there being no executor named in said Will, on the motion of Chapman Glover, who made oath to the said Will, and entered into and acknowledges a bond with security, conditioned according to law, certificate is granted the said Chapman Glover for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of the said Thos H Perkins dev^d with his will annexed in due form.
