I William M Cabell of Buckingham County Virginia being of sound mind & memory, do make this my last will & testament, hereby revoking all others made by me. I give to my beloved wife Mildred K Cabell my entire estate, real, personal & mixed. I request my wife to give my niece Mary J Morgan some of my family souvenirs & books & should she at any time be in need to aid her. This is discretionary with my wife, but not obligatory. I appoint Rolfe E Glover of the City of Richmond executor of this my will. I request the Court in which this my will may be probated to permit my executor to qualify without security. I direct that neither inventory nor appraisement be made of my estate. Witness my hand & seal this 30th day of January 1895

At a County Court held for Buckingham County, January 9th 1899.
This paper writing purporting to be the last will and testament of Wm M Cabell deceased, was this day produced in Court by Rolfe E Glover, the Executor therein named, and there being no subscribing witnesses thereto, P. A. Forbes and J. B. Williams were sworn, and severally deposed that they are well acquainted with the testator's handwriting, and verily believe the said handwriting, and the name thereto subscribed to be wholly written by the testator's own hand. Whereupon the said writing is ordered to be recorded as the true last will and testament of the said Wm M Cabell deceased. And on the motion of Rolfe E. Glover, the Executor therein named, who made oath thereto, and entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$2,000⁰⁰ without security, the testator directing by his will that none should be required, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form.
