I William Holman of the County of Buckingham do make this my last Will and
Testament in manner and form following that is to say

1st I desire that my Executor take charge of my estate both real and per-
sonal immediately after my decease and keep the same together for the
benefit of my wife Jane Holman and my children until my eldest child
arrives to lawful age, but should my wife Jane Holman marry before
either of my children arrives to lawful age, I desire that one third of
the personal part of my estate be immediately allotted off to her, which I
lend my wife Jane Holman during her life and after her decease to be
equally divided between my children.

2nd I desire that all the monies owing to me as well as all monies
arising at any time from my estate after educating and supporting my
children and my wife Jane Holman be laid out by my executor in such
property as they may think most beneficial to my estate.

3rd I desire that, if my wife Jane Holman remain a widow
until my eldest child arrives to lawful age in that case I desire that

one third of my land be immediately allotted to her, also one third of my personal estate which I lend to my wife Jane Holman during her life or widowhood, but should she intermarry, the land to be returned and equally divided between my children and after her decease the property which I have lent her to be returned and equally divided between my children.

4th I desire that the remainder of my estate be equally divided between my children as arrives to lawful age to be enjoyed by them and their heirs forever.

And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint William Mosley and Matthias Ayres executors of this my last Will and Testament revoking all other or former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 11th day of August 1823.
