✓ Do make this my last will and testament, hereby
revoking all other wills by me heretofore made.
First - I subject all my estate to the payment of
my just debts. - Item. I leave in trust to my son
George Sells two negro boys, Trust. James and Joe,
to be by him hired out, and the money arising
therefrom to be annually paid to my daughter
Lucy Bott, so long as she shall live, and after her
death to be equally divided among the said Lucy
Bott's children, or sold at the discretion of my exe-
cutor hereafter named, and the money equally
divided among the said children. - Item. I give
and bequeath to the children of my daughter Lucy
Bott eight hundred acres of land, part of a larger
tract of land containing one thousand acres,
lying in the County of Harding and State of Kentucky

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Bott's children, or sold at the discretion of my executor hereafter named, and the money equally divided among the said children. - Item - I give and bequeath to the children of my daughter Lucy Bott eight hundred acres of land, part of a larger tract of land containing one thousand acres, lying in the county of Harding and State of Kentucky to them and their heirs forever. - Item - The residue of the said tract of land, to wit, Two hundred acres I give and bequeath to the two children of my daughter Agnes Locke Bayles, now of the State of Kentucky, to them and their heirs forever. - Item - All the rest and residue of my estate I give and bequeath to my son George May, to him and his heirs forever. - I appoint my son George May my whole and sole executor, hereby giving him full power to sell and convey at his discretion

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the eight hundred acres of land given by this will to
the children of my daughter Lucy Bott, and when
sold to divide the money equally among them, or to
divide the land equally among them, if he should
think that it will be most for their interest. In
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my seal this 21st day of November one thou-
sand eight hundred and five.
