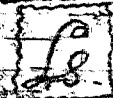


In the name of God Amen I Charles Jordan of Campbell

four Negroes to my loving Wife Martha Jordan to Wit, Charles
Silva Anthony and Will with there Increase to her and her
heirs forever. Likewise give my loving Wife all my House
furniture of every kind to her and her heirs forever. Likewise
four Horses likewise Twelve head of Cattle and all my
Stock of Hogs to her and her heirs forever. I give to my
said Wife One Hundred Acres of Land in Charlotte County
on Louse Creek to her and her heirs forever. I appoint
and Ordain my loving Wife and Jesse Tinsman Executors of
this my last Will and Testament revoking all other Wills. as
Witness my hand this Sixteenth day of June 1787 and Seal
Sam^l Morris Charles Timberlake Chas Jordan
