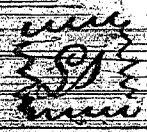

wife after paying all my Just Debts keep the whole
of my Estate both real and personal in her possession
during of her natural life and at her death to
make such division amongst our children as she
may think proper. I also constitute and appoint
my said wife Executrix to this my last will and
Testament as witness my hand and seal dated
as above.
