and sheep one bay mare together with all my
household and kitchen furniture with every other
species of property of which I may die possessed. In
the last place I constitute and appoint my son William
Bock my only Executor to this my last will and
testament made this 24th day of December 1801 as
witness my hand and seal

St John and Joel Bradner witnesses thereto subscribed
and Ordered to be Recorded And on the motion of William
Cook the Executor in the said Will named as he made
oath thereto according to Law giving security
whereupon he together with John Morris and
Denny Kelley his Securities entered into and
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of fifteen
hundred Dollars conditioned as the law directs for
the said Executors due and faithfull adminis-
tration of the said decedents estate and perform-
ance of his Will
