sins my body I Direct to be interred in a decent man-

ner at the direction of Executors hereafter named

my last Will I give and Dispose of such worldly

estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with

as follows in my wife's sole price in the manner and

following. I Give to my son Thomas

all the one sixth of my Lands lying on the

South Fork of Stovall's Creek in Amherst County

also all my Negroes young Slaves and Ponies a

mine and neat Cattle and Household furniture

following. I give to my son Thomas  
all the <sup>one</sup> ~~one~~ <sup>part</sup> of my Lands lying on the  
south side of Howards Creek in Amherst County  
also my Negroes Young Hapner and Jerry a  
mine and Head Cattle and Household furniture  
he has in possession also half Dozen Pewter plates  
I give to my son James Howell the other  
half of the above mentioned Lands also my  
Negroes Subler and Sam a mare and Head  
Cattle and Household furniture he has in Pos-  
sion also half Dozen Pewter plates. I give  
to my son Joseph Wilson Howell my Negroe  
Boys Jack and Louis also six head of Head  
Cattle a bay Horse two Claims one feather bed  
and furniture one Eight Gallon Pot and  
half Dozen Pewter Plates. I give to my

son

Son Bratt Stovall my Negroes Ben and Tedrick also  
a two year Old horse Colt he claims six head of Head  
Cattle one feather Bed and furniture one eight  
Gallon Pot and half Dozen Porcelain plates. I then  
I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Stovall my  
Girls Luce and Cloe a black mare she claims one  
feather bed and furniture Two Cows and Calves  
one Iron eight Gallon pot one large and one mid  
ding size disk one large and one middling size  
and  
Bason half Dozen porcelain plates I then I give to my  
Daughter Miller Stovall my Negroe Girls Miller  
and Cuzzab and the first child my Negroe  
menck Jude has also a young Phillery Colt now  
at the mare a Saddle and Bridle one feather bed  
and furniture Two Cows and Calves one Iron eight  
Gallon pot one large and one middling size  
two disks one large and one middling size Por  
celain Bason and half Dozen Porcelain plates I then

two fish one large and one midling size Por-  
ter Basson and half Dozen Porter plates. I her-  
by leave all my Lands on both side James River  
to be sold if my Executors think Proper and  
from the money arising from the sale of the  
Lands to Purchase a Tract of Land to be for the  
use my dear and loving Wife during her life  
or Widowhood and at her death or Marriage to  
be divided between my sons Joseph W. and  
Walter Stovall and all the Children of my Father  
not before mentioned and the money over and  
above if any that arises from the sale of my  
James River Land more they will Purchase a  
suitable Tract of Land to be continued as my Estate  
during my wife's life or Widowhood for the Bene-  
fit of her family and for the purpose of schools

long my children if my Executors think it  
improper to sell my ~~lives~~ ~~land~~ ~~land~~ it is to con-  
tribute for the benefit of my wife during her

life and Widowhood (read there at her death

in all things to be Equally Divided between

my sons Joseph W. Howell and Bratt Sta-

is and if my wife dies or marries before

my youngest son arrives to the age of 21 years

and the Estate is to be Continued as my Estate

until he does arrive to that age and then all

my Estate Excepted above the Legacies above

mentioned to be Equally Divided amongst

my sons as James Joseph W. and Bratt

Howell and if either of my children is young

and is dead then in the proportion of the

value of the Estate to make good that Deficiency

also & either of my sons Thomas James Joseph

also & either of my sons Thomas James Joseph  
W. and Brett Stovall die before they have  
their full Legacies to be divided between their  
surviving Brothers. My dying desire is that  
Childrens Legacies shall be delivered to them  
as they come to the age of Twenty One or twenty  
also my desire is that my estate may not be  
conveyed nor appointed. And I do hereby  
appoint my dear and loving Wife my Execu-  
trix and my sons Thomas James Joseph W.  
and Brett Stovall Executors to this my last

At a Court held for Campbell County September 5<sup>th</sup> 1782.

The within Last Will and Testament of George Stovall Junr Gent. deceased was proved by the Oaths of William Bradley Joseph Crews and Mary Turner Witnesses thereto Subscribed and Ordered to be Recorded. And on the motion of Mary Stovall the Executrix and Thomas Stovall and James Stovall two of the Executors therein named, who made Oath thereto according to Law, Certificate is granted them for obtaining Probate thereof in due form giving Security; Whereupon they together with John Dillard, Joseph Crews, William Bradley and Peter Hairston their Securities entered into and Acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of Five Thousand Pounds Conditioned as the Law directs for the said Executors due and faithfull Administration of the said Deceaseds Estate and performance of his Will. Liberty being reserved the other Executors.

Excecdent's Estate and performance of his Will.  
Liberty being reserved the other Executors in the  
said Will named to join in the probate thereof  
when they arrive of Lawfull age if they shall think  
fit.
