This my last Will and Testament and give my soul to God who gave it and my body to the dust to be buried in a decent and Christian burial and my worldly Estate consisting altogether of Debts owing by different persons to me as follows to wit by Charles Rock paid for him as his security in a bond to Daniel Murray the amount of which may be ascertained by reference had to the clerks office of the County Court of Campbell by Samuel Cunningham nine pounds ten shillings and after paying all my law full Debts the remainder I do will and bequeath to be equally Divided between my well beloved friends Thomas Botter and James Taylor, and I do constitute and appoint the said Thomas Botter and James Taylor Executors to this last will and Testament, Given under my hand and seal this fifth Day of December One Thousand

cutors to his last will and Testament, Given under my
hand and seal this fifth Day of December One Thousand
seven hundred and ninety eight Henry Truman Esq
