given <sup>to</sup> my Eldest Son George Rust fifty Pounds Cash

to his Useing. Fifthly I have given to my Son David Rust  
a certain Tract of Land lying Between Green Creek  
and Moly's Creek bounded as followeth Beginning at  
Moly's Creek at Samuel Martin's Corner thence  
Southward to Green Creek at W. D. Bird's Corner thence

I leave to be sold to best Advantage the Money a-  
rising from such Sale after paying my Wordly
