Woman "Suey" and her Increase that shall not be
mentioned in my will to him his heirs and assigns

Joanna also one House full of furniture and fine
Chest and two large stone jars which may contain
more than two gallons.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Joshua to have
one negro by name Isaac to him. His heirs and

Assigns forever also one bed and furniture and
pair of stulvards and a ~~small~~ sword

Item I give and bequeath to my son in Law Robert
Anderson my Turkey Land on Gilling River two
hundred Acres be the same more or less to

him his heirs and assigns forever also one negro man

Jack one negro girl Cady and all the stock of a
House full of goods not disposed of ~~above~~ by me

Barthina the wife of the said Robt. do and
leave all her of her Body then the negroes girl Cady
and Jack in case to be Equally Divided between

my two sons James and Joshua and and the 5th
and 6th the goods mentioned in this bequest is to
be Equally Divided between my two sons and Robt.

and such other goods mentioned in the bequest is
Equally divided between my two sons and
Anderson. And lastly I leave my Friend and
Nephew Steward With my Executor.
