

Wills. I, M. W. M. of God Amos I Mark Ward of
Campbell County being sick, weak in body but in sound sense of
mind, do hereby make and contain this my last Will and Testament
and first I give and bequeath my soul to God who gave it and my
body in the ground decently to be buried at the discretion of those
I leave behind me, and as to the worldly goods at last pleased the
Almighty God to bless me I bestow in manner following: I give
I give to Richard Holland the son of Polly Holland one division of
my Land in the County of Campbell, being a part of the tract of
Land whereon I now live, Beginning at John Masons line in the
Sandy bottom, thence straight lines to Joseph Cnaus line in said Wards
Spring branch, to him and his heirs forever. I then give and
bequeath to my wife Molly Ward my plantation, tools and the use
of my plantation with as much of my stock as may be judged ne-
cessary by any Executor hereafter named to be for her use and
support during her life or widowhood and at her death or mar-
riage to be sold and equally divided, among all her my said wifes
daughters to be for them and their heirs forever. I then give and

daughters to be for them and their heirs forever. I then Agreed
bequeath to Polly Holland the sum of five Pounds in Money
to be paid by my Executors immediately after my Death. I then Agreed to
Henry Henry one other division of my Land, that part whereon
Mr. W. Davells now lives Beginning at Marshall's line, thence
with said line to the Road, and along the said Road to Singleton's
line, to him and his heirs forever. I then I will that all my Dells
and just contracts be punctually paid, and all Dells due me be
collected as far as they can, and one third be given to my wife
as above written, and the other two thirds be given to her Daughters
according to the form and effect of the above division. I then
I will that my friend Nathl. Rogers be sole Executor to this my
Last Will and Testament, and that he make the divisions
within mentioned, and do hereby revoke and disannul all other
Wills by be made, and declare this to be my one true Last
Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have set my
