-dale one negro boy by the name of Will one young
black mare one feather bed and furniture one
cow and calf all which she has received and no
more to her and her heirs for ever. In the third
place I give and bequeath unto my beloved
daughter Lucy Rawlins alias Sterne one cow
and

and yearling and no more to her and her heirs for
ever my further will and desire is that my beloved
wife shall have the whole use and benefit of all my
estate real and personal for the support of her and
my afflicted son Albin Rawlins during her natural
life and after her decease my will and desire is
that the whole of the Estate in now possess or that may
be in being at the death of my beloved wife Mary
Rawlins be equally divided among my three be-
loved children not before mentioned in this Will
and Testament and in Order to make an equal
division I do hereby request and authorise my
trusty and beloved friends George Jude and Do-
rod Pease to divide my Estate above mentioned
