presence of two thousand Pounds con-
dition as the Law directs for the said
Executors due and faithful Administra-
tion of the said Decedents Estate and
performance of his Will. Security being

thereof in due form giving security where
upon he together with Charles Hall and
Jonathan Poffers his securities entered in
to and acknowledged their bond in the
presence of John Hines and Roger's cordis

performance of his Will. Liberty being

maine to join in the probate thereof
whom he shall think fit.
