I am. I do constitute and appoint Captain William Ward of Pittsylvania County my sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament and I do by these presents declare

William Ward of Hallowell County, Maryland
sole Executor of this my last Will and Testa-
ment and I do by these presents disavow
and make void all and every other will or
wills by me heretofore made. In Witness
