joyful and I do order that my Just Debts be paid
and satisfied. Item I give and bequeath my Negro

this is the case I give my little Negro girl namede Pate to
my daughter Betty and his heirs lawfully begotten

where Charles Talbot ran it once for the further confir-
ming the said land to the said Ralakin. I Order that
my son Robert Williamson make him the said Robert
Ralakin a good and Lawfull Title or Deed of Convey-
ance for the said land and Improvements there-
unto belonging. I Ratify and Confirm this and no
Other to be my last Will and Testament In Witness
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Affixed
my seal the day and year first above Written.
