Will and I do hereby give and bequeath to my beloved Daugh-

Gaulder One Cow and Calf each One feathered Bed and furniture
each to them and their heirs forever to be delivered up to them

by my Executors on their Marriage or Anniversary Day full
year from date and bequeath to my beloved son Micha-
el Gauden five Pounds at the death of my Wife Eliza-
beth Gauden. Item I give and bequeath to my beloved
son William Gauden Ten Pounds to be paid him at
the death of my said Wife. Item it is my desire that
after my Debts aforesaid are paid that all my Estate
both Real and Personal be lent and remain ⁱⁿ the possession
of my said Wife to her proper use and Benefit during
her Natural life Except the Legacy of my Daughters here-
before mentioned. It is also my Will and desire that at
the death of said Wife all the residue of my Estate after

Hillston Talbot and Thomas Marshall Trustees of any
three of them for this purpose that is to say if my said
Wife shall conceive it to be for the Interest of my Children
to make sale of the Land whereon I now live she is
hereby Authorised so to do in Case she shall have the
Concurrence of the said Trustees or any three of them
Notwithstanding any thing that has been mentioned
before in this my last Will and Testament and the
Money or Effects arising from the sale shall be applied
as I have heretofore mentioned by an Equal distribution
of the same among my Children. It is further my
Will and desire that should any Controversy arise
between my Legatees or Executors with respect to the

Construction intent bearing off this my last Will that this
same shall be referred to Robert Howard Richard Smith
and Charles Hoile Salbot or any two of them and their
decision shall be binding on the parties and their Opi-
