and their heirs forever my Will is that the
Land I Purchast of Robert Armstrong my
Executors hereafter named would get Pro-
per Deeds for the said Land of said Armistead

I do Appoint my loving wife and Joshua
Marriethall Jones George Jones Publius Jones
to be my Executors of this my last Will and
Testament whereunto I have set my hand
and seal this 25 day of May 1782

therein in due form giving Security whereupon
she together with John Boughton her Secu-
rity entered into and Acknowledged their
Bonds in the Penalty of five Hundred
pounds Conditioned as the Law Directs for
the said Executors due and faithful
administration of the said Decedent's estate
and performance of his Will Liberty being to
serve the Executors in the said Will named
to join in the Probate thereof when they shall
think fit.
