men once to die I hereby make ordain and consti-
tute this my last will and Testament revoking
and disannulling others made by me and as for
my last goods it hath pleased the Lord to bles-
s me well after all my just debts and funeral
expenses are paid I dispose off in the manner and
form following: Inasmuch as my desire is that all
my household and kitchen furniture be sold
also all my stock except a cow that now gives
milk I give unto my negro woman Hagar and
her three children of her own will and

for me following, I promise my desire is that all
my household and kitchen furniture be sold
also all my stock except a cow that now gives
milk & give unto my negro woman Hannah
and three barrels of corn, my father will and
desire is, and I do hereby appoint and consti-
tute my beloved son John Morris and Robert
Hannibal executors of this my last will and
testament as witness my hand and seal
this fifteenth day of December eighteen hundred
and forty.
