my household and kitchen furniture be sold &
also all my stock except a cow that now gives
milk. I give unto my negro woman Hannah
and three barrels of corn, my further will and
desire is, and I do hereby appoint and consti-
tute my beloved son John Morris and Robert
Smith as Executors of this my last will and
Testament as Witness my hand and seal
this fifteenth day of December eighteen hun-
dred.

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A Court Held for Campbell County January 12th 1801

Dollars conditioned as the Law directs for the said
Executors due and faithful administration on
the said decedents Estate and performance

the said Will named who made oath thereto -
according to Law certificate is granted him for
obtaining probate thereof in due form giving
Security Whereupon he together with Micajah
Clark his security entered into and acknowledged
their bond in the Penalty of five hundred
Dollars conditioned as the Law directs for the said
Executors due and faithfull administration on
the said decedents Estate and performance
of his Will. Liberty being reserved the other
executor in the said Will named to Join
in the probate thereof when he shall think fit
