for the hire of Brannon which bonds are in the hands  
of Thomas Baugh also I desire my negroes Brannon  
and Jack to be hired annuallly to raise a sum for the  
payment of my lawful debts after which payment  
all the sum arising from the hire of Jack to given  
to one of the twins of Bartlett Baugh by the name  
of Richard and then his brother John when he comes  
of lawful age to have the said Jack as his to enjoy  
after my decease forever also Brannon and Dick I  
give to Thomas Baugh and the feather bed whereon  
I now lie to be then given to the sd Baugh, and

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sale of Oxen and another bond from the sd Stovall  
for the hire of Branson which bonds are in the hands  
of Thomas Baugh also I devise my negroes Brannon  
and Jack to be hired annually to raise a sum for the  
payment of my lawful debts after which payment  
all the sum arising from the hire of Jack to given  
to one of the twins of Bartlett Baugh by the name  
of Richard and then his brother John when he comes  
of lawful age to have the said Jack as his to enjoy  
after my decease forever also Brannon and Dick I  
give to Thomas Baugh and the feather bed whereon  
I now lie to be then given to the sd Baugh, and  
Joseph Denwoody to have all my stock of horses  
cattle and hogs. And I appoint the said Joseph  
Denwoody to execute this my last Will and testa-  
ment as witness my hand and seal this fifteenth  
day of December one thousand eight hundred  
and two
