shoes and knee Buckels that I now wear and
they the whole of the remaining part of my Estate
I allow to be Equally divided amongst my Chil
dren at my wifes Decease. Viz, to my Daughter
Racine Keene One part to her and her heirs for
ever 2 to my son Elijah One part to him and his
heirs forever 3 to Merrigan One Part to her and her
heirs forever 4 to Willey Spiers One part to him

and his heirs forever 5 to Samuel one part to him
and his heirs forever 6 to Josiah one part to him and
his heirs forever and I appoint my son Ebenezer Brown
and Jesse Greenham and Colo. Edward Seaborn to be
