and weak in body but in my proper sense Memory and
understanding Blessed be God do here make this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form following
I give I give I give unto my loving wife Ann Marshall the
land and plantation whereon I now live and my just Mill
during her natural life - I also give unto my dear son
Samuel Marshall my land called Hampton and part
of said I now live on Beginning at the Mouth of the branch
referred to in the will thence a straight line to the fork of Hampton
Road to my left side line thence along my said line to
Hampton line to him and his heirs for ever I also give
and bequeath unto him my dear son John Marshall
my son Lewis and Leather belt and Furniture to him and
my son James my son John and my son William

to my son and daughter bed and furniture to my son
and daughter forever. I give and bequeath to my son
Daniel Marshall my Land above John Blacks vision
and the same contains two hundred and fifty
acres be the same more or less my Negro fellow
called my Negro I'd named Aggy one further and one
further and one Horse saddle and bridle to my son
and daughter forever. I give and bequeath to my son
and daughter Marshall my Land and Plantation with
the same and the same contains one below John Blacks vision
two hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less
I give and bequeath to my son Daniel Marshall
my Negro fellow called my Negro Ben named Ben
one further bed and furniture one Horse bridle and saddle
to my son and daughter forever. I give and bequeath

to my son Joseph all the Gravel Parcel of Land
which I now have containing four hundred Acres be
the same more or less my Negro Boy named Joseph
as a my Negro Girl named Ester. One feather Bed and
furniture One horse Bridle and Saddle to him his
heirs and assigns forever. I Herby Give and bequeath
to my Daughter Rachel Black my Negro Wench
named Hannah and two children named Alice to her
and her heirs forever. I Herby Give and bequeath to
my daughter Nancy a Negro Boy named
Jack and my Negro Girl named Rachel to her and
her heirs forever. I Herby Give and bequeath to my
Daughter Mary Harshall my Negro Boy named Sam
and Negro Girl named in faith one feather Bed and
furniture and One side Saddle to her and her heirs
forever. I Herby Give and bequeath to my Daughter

unlawful and contrary to law and her will
to wit. I give and bequeath to my daughter
Betsey Russell my Negro Boy named Stephen
and my Negro Girl named Hebe or a feather Bed
and furniture and one black saddle to her and her
heirs for ever. Also I desire that all my Just Debts
maybe due by my Executors Out of my Estate
and as for the residue or remainder of my Estate
my Will and desire is that the same may remain
in my loving Wife Ann Marshall's hands during
her Natural life and at her death if there shall
be any Negroes belonging to my Estate I desire that they may
be equally divided among all my Children and as
touching my Household Goods and Stocks my Will
and desire is that my loving Wife Ann Marshall
may act and do with them as she shall think most

Conveniently for the Benefit of my children. I do hereby
appoint make and Ordain my loving Wife Mrs. Ann
shall Executors and my sons William and Daniel
Marshall Executors of this my last Will and Testa-
ment ratifying and Confirming this and no other
to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and
year first above Written.

At a Court held for Campbell County August 5th 1787

That this last Will and Testament of William
Marshall Deed was proved by the Oaths of the Jurors

The said deed was formed by the votes of the Whigs
therein subscribed And ordered to be recorded. And on
the motion of the said Marshall (for a certificate and Wit-
ness) the said petitioned Daniel Marshall the said
therein named voters to wit John Galt the said according to
said certificate is granted them for testimony
hereof in and for giving security. Whereupon
they together with William Brown James Bullock
and others agreed that the said certificate and the
said signed their Bond in the penalty of Ten thousand
pounds conditioned as the said Deeds for the said
Executors due and faithful administration of the
said Deceaseds Estate And performance of his Will
