natural life or widowhood and at her death it is my will and de
sire that my executors hereafter named sell my land, slaves and
personal estate on credit months credit and the monies arising
from such sale to divide among my children in the following
manner that is to say. I give unto Nancy Taylor and Thomas
Winterborn one ninth part of the whole of my estate after the same
shall have been sold as before directed to be equally divided be
tween them to their heirs and assigns forever. Then I give
unto Bennett Seal my son one ninth part of my estate to him
and his heirs forever. Then I give to my son John Seal one
ninth part of my estate to him and his heirs forever. Then I
give unto my sons Bennett and John Seal one other ninth
part of my estate equally to be divided between them which

... give to my son John Seal one
ninth part of my estate to himself and his heirs forever. Then I
give unto my sons Bennett and John Seal one other ninth
part of my estate equally to be divided between them which
said ninth part would have been given to my son David had
he lived but since it has pleased God to take him from this
world I do hereby give this part as before mentioned to Bennett
and John Seal ~~to be equally divided between them to their~~
~~heirs and assigns forever.~~ Then I have unto my children named
Thomas, Mary & Elizabeth ^{www.virginiapioneers.net} Seal and Elizabeth Seal
each one ninth part of my estate, and at their or each of their death
he or she having no issue that their parts shall be equally
^{belonging} divided ~~between~~ their survivors. It is my will and desire that my executors
shall pay only the interest on such part to each of my children
last mentioned and at their deaths they shall ~~pay~~ ^{convey} over to the
child or children of each as they shall come of age or marry the
full share which their father or mother would have been
willing to have the same been absolutely given. Then I give

into my son I desire have such one dollar and no other
part of my estate. I constitute and appoint my wife Is-
abella Executrix and my friends Benjamin Hunt and John
Gayle execs. to this my last will and testament I witness
whereof these have set my hand and seal this 31st day of
July 1818.
