heretofore made first I bequeath my Soul into the hands of my Saviour
Jesus Christ hoping for a full Pardon of all my sins at the Resurrec-
tion of the Just and my Body to be Decently Entred at the Discre-
tion of my Executors hereafter Named and as for my Temperate
Estate which it hath pleased God to bless me with, all after my
Debts Legacies funeral Charges are paid I leave in manner and
form following Viz -

- Item - I Give and Bequeath unto my Son Henry Chandler two Negroes Dany
and Gabril to him and his Heirs forever -
- Item - I Give and Bequeath to my son William Chandler two Negroes
James and Matt to him and his Heirs forever -
- Item - I Give and Bequeath to my son Edmund Chandler Part of that
Tract of Land whereon I now live beginning at the shoalhouse
Down to the River and all above the River on the west side
I also purchased of Lucy Chandler

Excepting Thirtyseven acres & I
I Give him all the Rest above the Road Containing too
& Sixty Acres be the same more or Less I also Give him
too Negroes Lewey & Judy a Bed and furniture one Cow & Calf
one sow and pigs one Dish and six Plates and three Chairs
to him and his Heirs forever —

~~Item~~ I Give and Bequeath to my son Robert
ainder Part of that Tract of Land whereon I now
Live Below the Road from the Schoolhouse on the East
Side of the Road Containing one Hundred Eighty &
Nine Acres be the same more or Less I also Give
him four Negroes Gloster & Tom Phillis & her Child Milly
a Bed and furniture one Cow and Calf one yearling
one Cart one Large walnut Tabel one Dish and six Plates
and three Chairs to him and his Heirs forever
Likewise it is my Desire that my son Robert Chandler
shall pay his Brother Edmund Chandler Twenty Pounds
out of his Part of the Estate Left him —

Item I Lend to my Daughter Lucy Birt Three Negroes During
Her Natural Life one Negro fellow named Jim one wench
named Peg one Girl named Luloy and after her Natural
Life is Ended I Give them to her Heir or Heirs of her Body
to be Equally Divided amongst them and their Heirs forever
But for want of such Heir or Heirs of her Body then to
Return them, and their Increase to be Equally Divided
amongst all my Children to them and their Heirs forever

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I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Lucy Chandler four
Negroes a wench named Patt a wench named Easter and her two
Children Jo & Choney I also Give her two Beds and Furniture
and all the Bed Quilts she has made for her self or Claims
as hereon I also Give her one Sorrel Mare and all her
Increase and one Cow and calf one Dish and six Plates
to Her and her Heirs forever —

I Give to Anne Brown for services on that Land I Purchased

of Lucy Chiles Containing Thirty seven Acres Likewise
one Bed and fineture with a Copras Dimonted Counterspin
with Blue spots a Nother Blue Dimonted one with Red
spots and all the Bed Quilts she has made for her
self or Claims as hern also a Beast of ten Pounds
Value a Cow & Calf a sow & Pigs one small Burch.

Javel & Looking Glass, & Twenty Pounds Cash to be
Raised out of my Estate and Paid to her for money
I Borrowed some years ago to her and her heirs
forever

and it is my Desier, that all my sheep may be Divided
between William Chandler Edmund Chandler Robert Chandler
& Lucy Chandler as the Best have had Part of the stock
and the Best of my Horses which I have not will
away after my debts are Paid to be Equally
Divided amongst my Children & Mine

Henry Chandler William Chandler Edmund Chandler Robert
Chandler & Fanny Hackett Sally Jones Molley Bibb &
Lucy Chandler to them and Their heirs forever

Item I do also appoint Daniel Coleman & Samuel Coleman &
John Brown my Executors of this my Last will and Testament
Revolking all other Wills heretofore made in Testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this
in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred
and Ninety Eight A.
