Wife (not named) five negroes, Old Ballock, Young Dick, Seller, Dannel and Grace for her lifetime and then to be set free. David Dickerson, son of Samuel Dickerson, one negro named Hannah, daughter of Nan. Thomas Guy, son of Thomas Guy, one negro named Mime. Reubin George one bay horse named Jolly. John Thilman, Sr. three negroes, Burtis, Gift and Anny, to use to maintain his daughter, Jane Thilman. Thomas Mills two negroes named Hannah and Tom for repairing my house. Susannah Ferrell two negroes named George and Rachel. Susannah Hackett one negro named Poll and a negro man named Young Ballock. After Susannah Hackett death, said negroes go to Thomas Mills and Thomas Hackett to be equally divided.
