dearly-beloved Wife, Margret Collins my whole Estate, real and
personal during her Widowhood and after her decease it
is my desire that the Land should be equally divided between
my two sons Thomas Collins and Joseph Collins and it is my
desire that these my two Sons Thomas Collins and Joseph
Collins shall have each of them a Horse, Saddle & Bridle
and one half apiece and remainder of my Estate I give and
bequeath to my two Sons Thomas Collins and Joseph Collins
