Last Will and Testament In the first place I will and devise to my son John my
share by Charles to him and his heirs and assigns forever and the balance of
my Estate both real and personal of every kind and nature becom after my debts
and first paid I will and desire that my dear Wife Fanny may enjoy and
have the use of, until my said son John shall arrive to the age of twenty one
years, then I will and direct that an equal division shall take place between
my said Wife and son of the aforesaid balance of my Estate to them and their
heirs and assigns forever - intending hereby that my said son shall be maintained
and educated out of the fund devised my Wife during his minority I will and
appoint my said beloved Wife Fanny and my friend William Thompson Executors and
Governors of this my last Will and Testament who are hereby authorized by this my Will
to sell such part of my Estate either real or personal as may appear proper & convenient
to them for the purposes above mentioned - particularly should my said beloved
Wife wish to remove to the Western Country with her friends who are now going I
will and direct that the said my aforesaid Executors sell my land and such other property as may
seem proper and convenient to them as aforesaid - in case my aforesaid son John shall die
under age I will and desire that my said Wife shall inherit her part of my Estate
as aforesaid - In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 1st day of

to make for the purposes above mentioned. Particularly should my said beloved
Wife wish to remove to the Western Country with her friends who are now going &
will and direct that everything aforesaid be sold my land and such other property as may
seem proper and convenient to them as aforesaid. In Case my aforesaid son John shall die
under age I will and direct that my beloved Wife shall inherit her part of my Estate
