all men once to die do on this Twentieth day of September in the year of
our Lord One thousand seven hundred & ninety five make Ordain
& publish this my last will & Testament and first I commit my
Body to the Earth to be decently bury'd at the discretion of my
Executors hereafter named my soul I commend to Almighty God my
maker hoping for a remission of all my sins thro the merits of Jesus
Christ my saviour. and as touching my worldly goods wherewith it
hath pleased God to Bless me in this life. I give devise & bequeath
the same in manner here following. That is to say. I lend to my
Wife Elizabeth, One third part of the Land & plantation whereon
I now live, to include my dwelling house, and extend where her
Choice may direct during her natural life. Then I give to my
son Henry Hines a black horse called Jack. I give to my son
James Hines all my land on the East side of Great House Creek
being that on which my s^d son now lives to him & his heirs or
assigns forever. I give to my son William Hines the residue of my
land after my wifes third part aforesaid is laid off also
that said third part after my wifes decease to him & his heirs

And after my wifes third part aforementioned is laid off also

or assigns forever. I give to my Daughter Fanny Hewitt
a negro Woman named Abby with her future increase, to my
my said Daughter, her heirs or assigns forever. I give to my
Daughters Betsey Hines & Patsy Hines a negro ^{man} named Jerry
my two said daughters to hold Equal Shares in said negro
to them their heirs or assigns forever. I give to my Gr^d daughter
Patsy Hines daughter of my Daughter Catey Hines, a negro
boy named Jacob to her & her heirs forever. And my Will
farther is that, all my Estate not heretofore mentioned
(viz) my House hold furniture, plantation Utensils and stock
of all kinds, be sold on twelve months Credit & the money
arising from such sale, to be divided as follows. One
third part I lend to my wife Elizabeth during her
natural life, & after her decease to descend to my son Thos
Hines to him his heirs or assigns forever. One other third part
I give to my Daughter Catey Hines to her her heirs or assigns
forever. And the remaining third part I give to my daughter

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I being much diseased James & Vally Hines a negro ^{man} named Jerry
my two said daughters to hold equal shares in said negro
to them their heirs or assigns forever. I give to my Gr^d daughter
Palsey Hines daughter of my Daughter Catey Hines, a negro
boy named Jacob to her & her heirs forever. And my Will
farther is that, all my Estate not heretofore mentioned
(viz) my house hold furniture, plantation Utensils and stock
of all kinds, be sold on twelve months Credit & the money
arising from such sale to be divided as follows. One
third part I lend to my wife Elizabeth during her
natural life, & after her decease to descend to my son Thos
Hines to him his heirs or assigns forever. One other third part
I give to my Daughter Catey Hines to her her heirs or assigns
forever. And the remaining third part I give to my daughter
Polly Hines, to her her heirs or assigns forever. And lastly I do
appoint my friends James Pattillo my son James Hines
& my son in law Thomas Hewitt executors of this my last
Will & Testament hereby Revoking all former Wills by me made
