endow me with I bestow as followeth. Item I leave in the hands of my
Wife Tabitha Hunt all my personal Estate, both my household stuff
and Stock of Horses, Cattle, Hogs and Corn to raise my Children until
the Youngest comes of Age or is married, my Will and desire is that my
Estate then shall be divided, the one third part I give to my Wife Tabitha,
the other two thirds to be equally divided betwixt my five Children (Viz)
James, Mary Ann, Sarah, Elizabeth and Nancy Share and Share alike.
I do appoint my Wife Tabitha Hunt and David Hunt my Executors of
this my last Will and Testament. As Witness my hand and Seal this 15.th
day of October 1785

and the same was proved by the oath of John Hoggatt and Joseph Hunt the
Witnesses hereto Subscribed, and Ordered to be Recorded. On the motion of
the said Executrix who made oath according to Law, Certificate is granted
her for obtaining a probat of the said Will in due form, she giving Security
whereupon she with Jacob Huntsman, Joseph Ward and Edmund Dumpter
her Sureties, entered into and acknowledged their Bond for that purpose.
Reserving liberty to David Hunt the other Executor to join in the probat
hereof when he shall think fit.
