

David Hight of the County of Charlotte Virginia being sick but sound in mind and judgment
do will and bequath my estate in the following manner (to wit) the land on which my son Isham lies containing
about eight acres lying adjoining Robert Williams's tract I lend to the said Isham during his natural
life after his death I give it to my son Westmarland and his heirs forever that part of the tract
which I now dwell containing about one hundred & ninety acres I lend to my wife Susanna
Hight during her natural life after which I also give the said land to Westmarland Hight
and his heirs forever I give to each of my Daughters Christiana and Susanna a good feather bed
& furniture after which the whole of my household furniture must be equally divided between ^{my} wife
Susanna Hight my Daughter Elizabeth McKim, Benjamin Hight, Guardner Hight, David
Hight, Isham Hight, Treman Hight, Westmarland Hight, Christian Hight, Susanna
Hight, and the children of my Daughter Mary Lambert my negro man Benjamin
I lend to my wife Susanna Hight during her natural life then give him to Westmarland
Hight and his heirs forever; I leave my horse for the use of the plantation and those who live on
it my stock of all kinds I give to my wife Susanna and those ^{of my} children living with her
Stephen Farmer & Westmarland Hight to execute the above will, In Witness whereof I sign
my hand and seal this 28th day of Sep^r 1794 as my last will and Testament
