I Give to my Mother Sister Bailey my lands whereon I now live and all my Stock hogs and horse and a bond of forty dollars on Daniel Weatherford and the money that is in my Uncle Henry Bailey's hands after all my just debts is paid and after her death I give it my Sister Susannah at her disposal forever. At Witness my hand and Seal this first day of July one thousand eight hundred and five.

Charlotte County, Virginia Wills 1791-1805

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At a Court held for Charlotte County the 10 day of October 1805.
On the motion of Lewis Blankenship who made oath according to Law Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration of the Estate of Duke Harley and with this his Will annexed he gave security in sum with Thomas Chapin for his Surety entered into & Acknowledged as their bond according to Law for that purpose. Priscilla Harley the mother of the said Duke Harley having first by her Letter addressed to this Court relinquished her right of administration to this said Estate.
