containing to corner Shrub Oak and red Oak on the back line by a path, to him and his heirs forever
I then I give to my well Beloved Son Joseph ^{Fugua} all the ^{upper} ~~land~~ ^{end} of the above Land from the said li-
above mentioned up to the mouth of Turnip Creek and all the upper end of the same to him and
his heirs forever I then, I give to my well beloved Son Joseph Fugua the following Slaves to wit, Dick, Luce
and all the younger and the child that said the Older is now pregnant with, I then, I give to my well
Beloved son Moses Fugua the following Slaves, to wit, ^{Among the} Older, Tom and Joe, I then, I give and Bequeath
To my well Beloved son Samuel Fugua the following Slaves, to wit, Bolt, Tom and Mary the younger
I then, I give and bequeath to Josiah Macey the same, I then, I give to the commander of Madford Macey
Children to be Equally divided, I then, I give and Bequeath to my son William Fugua's children
will and all, I then, I give and Bequeath to John Fugua Cloe, James and Binneth and William F.

I am, I give and bequeath to Josiah Macy one cow and calf and sow and pigs, I am
I give to Moses Fugua one feather bed and furniture, I am, I give and bequeath to my Loving sons Joseph
Fugua Moses Fugua and Samuel Fugua all the Remainder part of my Land and moveable Estate
Equally divided, and I do further more appoint my ^{wife} beloved sons Joseph Fugua, Moses Fugua and Samuel
Fugua Executors of this my Last will and testament and I do utterly disallow and disanul all former
wills and testaments by me before made allowing this and no other to be my Last will and Testament
