Constitute this my Last Will and Testament in manner by form as follows
My Soul I Give to Almighty God who gave it me my body to the Earth
Decently Buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named and to
my Temporal Estate which it has pleased God to bestow on me I Give and bequeath
as follows my will is that my Debts and funeral Charges first be paid
I Give to my beloved Cousin Elizabeth Trappan one feather bed and furniture
and her heirs forever. But my mother Elizabeth Toombs ^{during her life} and to the Girl
Directly, I Give to Beloved Cousin Sarah Washam one negro Girl and
back to her and her heirs for ever and if she die without heir the first living
Child my sister Mary Washam has my will is that my Executors keep her up
till the Child
come of age only to shall have seven pounds ten Shillings for the use of her
I Give to my beloved Cousin Elizabeth Toombs seven pounds

that my sister Mary Worham has my will is that my Executors pay me
till the child.

come of age only he shall have seven pounds ten Shillings for the use hereof
mentioned; And I Give to my beloved Cousin Elizabeth Tombs seven pound

Shillings to be paid when she is of this negro comes of age. I appoint my
