Estate for her maintenance, but should my Wife intermarry with any person then
to my Will and desire, that the part which I leave her, shall not remain in the said
Sarahs possession, but be equally divided amongst my sons hereafter named. Item
I give unto my Daughter Catharine Tucker, five Shillings to her and her heirs forever.
Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Amy Barnes, one feather bed &
furniture, to the value of Ten pounds. One Horse and Saddle, to the value of Ten pounds
and thirty five pounds, ^{at her marriage} to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath
unto my Daughter Elizabeth Barnes, one feather bed and furniture to the
value of ten pounds, one Horse and saddle to the value of ten pounds, and thirty
five pounds to be paid to her at her marriage, to her and her heirs forever. Item I give
and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Barnes one feather bed and furniture
to the value of ten pounds, also one Horse and saddle to the value of ten pounds &
thirty five pounds to be paid unto her at her marriage to her and her heirs forever.

I give unto my Daughter Catharine Butler, five Shillings to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Barnes, one feather bed and furniture to the value of Ten pounds. One Horse and Saddle, to the value of Ten pounds and Thirty five pounds, ^{at her Marriage} to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Barnes, one feather bed and furniture to the value of ten pounds, one Horse and saddle to the value of ten pounds, and thirty five pounds to be paid to her at her marriage, to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Barnes one feather bed and furniture to the value of ten pounds, also one horse and saddle to the value of ten pounds and thirty five pounds to be paid unto her at her marriage to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Barnes one feather bed and furniture to the value of ten pounds also one horse and saddle to the value of ten pounds and thirty five pounds to be paid to her at her marriage.

But provided either of my before named Daughters ^{die} before they are married, then it is my will and desire their party which Father and I gave them, shall be equally divided between my sons

Henry, Daniel, Gabriel, John, William, Thomas and James. — Item My will and desire that after the decease of

that the residue of my Estate both real and personal be equally divided among
my Sons before named when my youngest son arrives at the age of Twenty
Years and also my Will that Henry Barnes, Daniel Barnes & George
Barnes provide good schooling for my Children which is to be paid
from the profits of my Estate which I have, may be kept together for that
purpose and at the age of Eighteen years of my Son William John Thomas
and Leonard to my Will that each may be bound out to some good trade
they having it in their power to chose their Master and at the age of Twenty
years its my desire that they may be at liberty to themselves and
should either of my Sons dies before they come of age then my Will and
desire is that his or their parts be equally divided among the Surviving Sons
Item its my Will and desire that James Tilly have one year schooling
which is to be paid for out of my Estate. Item its my Will and desire
that my Executors make sale of a Tract of Land known by the still track
to the best advantage where they see cause also I desire that my Still
may be sold for the best price they can get. Item its my Will and desire
that if the Child that my Wife is now pregnant with be a boy for him
to have an equal part with the Rest of my Sons before named. But should
