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In the Name of God Amen, I Henry Robertson of Charlotte County being in perfect mind and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say I Impresis After all my just debts are paid them I give and bequeath to my two sons Jonathan Brooks and Henry Robertson's my tract of land I had of Nicholas Vaughan and all my land lying on the Water Creek and the east side of Milestone Creek to be equally divided between them, also I give to my son ^{Jonathan} Brooks Robertson three negro Abram, May, Murren, I also give to my son Henry Robertson three negro Ned, Pimus, Philb, I Item my desire is that my Daughter Anne Farley Shant inherit any more of my estate than what I have already given her, Item, I give and bequeath to my Daughter Susanna Robertson five negro viz, Sunday

John, Franky, Dolly, David, also one feather bed and furniture and one horse and saddle. Item, I give to my beloved wife Johanna Robertson during her natural life, four negro viz, Banks, Davey, Siller and Bobb also all my household and kitchen furniture stock of all kinds horses, cattle, sheep and hogs and will to be at her discretion to dispose of to my four sons as she thinks proper I Brooks, Henry, William and Christopher Robertson's. Item, I give and bequeath to my son William Robertson my tract of land and ordinary in Halifax County. Item I give and bequeath to my son Christopher Robertson my tract of land where I now live, his mother having possession of the house and plantation during her natural life, also I give and bequeath to my two sons William and Christopher Robertson all the rest residue of my negroes not mentioned to be equally divided between them And I do nominate and appoint my beloved wife Johanna Robertson, William Robertson and Christopher Robertson executors of this my last Will and Testament revoking all former wills by me ^{made} made.
