and if her death or Marriage then I give and bequeath all My Land lying the North side
of the Creek to My son Austin Loggins and his heirs forever, I Give and bequeath
all the Remainder part of My Land lying the North side of the Creek when I am
dead to My son William Loggins and his heirs forever the same Creek to be the divi-
ding line between them - I Give and bequeath to My son Dixon Loggins one Shilling
Sterling Money, I Give to My wife Martin Loggins one Shilling Sterling Money
I Give to my Grand daughter Ann Cutler one Shilling with all its profits in-
crease in the Day of my daughter Sarah Cutler's part, I Give and bequeath
all the Unimproved part of My estate not already given, to the Remainder of My son Chas-
les that is Ann Loggins, William Loggins, Hannah Loggins and Charles and William
Loggins to them and their heirs forever I do hereby appoint My beloved friend Thomas
Bedman Executor to this My last Will and Testament, touching and annulling all
