 it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make and ordain this my
 Testament that is to say and principally and first of all I give and
 my soul into the hands of God that gave it And my body I commit
 to the Earth to be buried in a Christian manner at the Discretion of
 Executors nothing Doubting but at the Resurrection I shall receive them
 again by the mighty Power of God and as touching such Worldly Estate
 with it hath pleased God to Bless me in this life I give and Dispose
 following manner and form, And first it is my will and I do order
 first Place all my Just Debts and funeral Charges be paid and Satisfied
 Then I do ordain that this Land I now live on be sold by my Executors and proper
 Lawful title made to the purchaser by my Executors and that the purchase

with all my other Effects be continued in my Sister Catharine's possession and
Liberty to make such a purchase or purchases as she shall think
proper During life and her Estate an Equal Division to be made with
her of Francis Harwood and her, George Thomas Harwood, and
other Harwoods, and in case she should die without issue her
fall to most her by her mother's side. And I do hereby appoint and
my Sister Catharine, & George Harwood Executors of this my last Will and
testament, and do hereby make and demand all former Wills by me heretofore
as Witness my hand and seal the day and Year above written
