of my Executor hereafter named. I then I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin
Green all that part of my land lying on the west side of Arnolds Branch, and from the
mouth of the said Branch crossing the same branch to the corner also one feather
rod to him I give it to him here forever. I then I give and bequeath to my daughter
Fanny Arnold 1/2 acre by the stream of Delram and also one feather rod which said she
has now in possession to her I give it to her here forever - and the rest of my estate both
real & personal I leave to My beloved wife Phebe during her natural life or widowhood
to raise my small children upon and at her death or marriage my desire is that it may
be equally divided between my children hereafter mentioned to wit, William Green, Pelly Green,
Samuel Green, James Green & John Green. I do hereby appoint Benjamin Green to execute
this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made. In witness
