 and Recommend my soul to God that giveth and for my Body I recommend it to the earth
 to be buried in a Decent manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at
 the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God and as
 touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life
 I give devise and dispose of in manner and form following that is to say In the first place
 I give and Bequeath to my Wife Margery Lackland the third part of all the Lands I
 possess & likewise five Slaves and their increase for the time she continues my widow (viz)
 Henry Phillis, Lucy, Winny, Adam and their increase for the time aforesaid and after
 decease or marriage three of the aforesaid negroes (viz) Winny, Lucy and Adam and their increase
 to be equally divided between my three Sons James, Zadoc and John and all my stock
 of hoes Cattle Sheep and hogs and household furniture for my wifes use during the time
 aforesaid and after decease or Relinquishment the other two negroes Anthony and Phillis
 and their increase to be equally divided between my Daughters Elizabeth, Rachel and
 Margery. Item I give to my four Grand Children Margary Harding, Eliza Harding,

and their increase to be equally divided between my Daughters Elizabeth, Rachel and
Margery. Item I give to my four Grand Children Margary Harding, Elonor Harding
anna Harding, John Lackland Harding a negro wench named nan and her increase
to be sold by my son James Lackland and the money equally to be divided between the
aforesaid Grand Children when they come to Lawful age. Item, I give to my son James
Lackland and his Assigns a negro boy named Robin. Item, I give to my son Zadock and
his Assigns a negro boy named Ben. Item I give to my Daughter Mary Bell and her assign
a negre boy named Dick. Item I give to my ^{daughter} Anna Woodson and her Assigns a negro girl
named Margaret. Item I give to my Daughter Elizth Lackland and her Assigns a negro
Boy named Simon. Item, I give to my Daughter Margery Lackland and her Assigns
a negro girl named Prief. Item I give to my son John Lackland when he is at Lawful
age three negroes (W^{ch}) mingo, Abiam, and Candis and it is my desire that my Executors hereafter

 and ordered to be Recorded, and on the motion of the said Executor and Executrix, who made oath
 according to Law, Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due
 form, they giving security Whereupon they together with Robert Caldwell, Moore Sumpter
 and John Bland their securities, entered into and acknowledged their bond for that purpose
