to the purchaser and also to make such purchase of Land and Negroes as

It will be in the name of the Lord Amen

to the purchaser and also to make such purchaser of Land and Negroes as  
shall think most Advantageous for the Benefit of my Children. Item my  
Son John <sup>being</sup> of age I allow an Equal Division of all my Estate to be made  
Betwixt my four Sons to wit, John, James, Samuel, & Robert Middleton; &  
I do hereby authorize and appoint Robert Woods and Thomas Moore my  
Executors the Executors of this my Last Will and Testament and do hereby  
cancel all former Wills & Testaments as Witness my hand and seal this Twenty  
October one thousand one hundred & sixty four.
