quantity and quality to be divided by three men mutually chosen by them.

Item I give to my brother Thomas Russell and my Sister Peggy Russell
after the death of my mother Anne Russell my negro man Moses to them
and their heirs forever. Item I wish all the debts due me to be collected and
all debts due from me to be paid and the surplus money due me together
with the money arising from the sale of my Carpenter's tools with all other
things belonging to me not herein mentioned, I give to my Mother
Anne Russell to her and her heirs forever. Lastly I appoint my brother
Thomas Russell executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking
all others. In Witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 6th
day of January 1803.
