I John Sandefur of Charlotte County being weak in body but sound in mind and memory
and considering it is allotted for all men to die I hereby make and Ordain this my last Will and
Testament. and as for my worldly estate my ^{only} desire is that after any just debts and
funeral expenses are paid it shall be disposed in the manner and form following. In witness
Whereof I have signed my name and seal this 10th day of June 1861. My last Will and desire is that my beloved Wife Linnah Sandefur shall enjoy and possess
the whole of my estate both real and personal during her natural life to use and direct as
she and my executors hereafter named may think proper for the advantage of the same.
In the above I have named and bequeathed to my beloved Linnah Sandefur the sum of
one negro girl by the name of Jane. And the sum of one hundred dollars to be paid to my
beloved Linnah Sandefur at the death of the said John Sandefur.

In the fourth place I give and bequeath unto my beloved Grand Daughter
our negro Girl by the name of Lucy fifty Acres and bequeath unto my beloved
Grandson Beverly Brown one negro boy by the name of Buster fifty Acres and
bequeath unto my beloved Grand daughter Susan Brown one negro Girl by the name of
Nancy - My further Will and desire is that all my Grand Children above named shall
have good schooling to be paid for out of the profits of my estate, and after my Grandson
Beverly Brown has a good learning my desire is that he and the negro boy Buster
shall be bound to some good trade - My further desire is that as far as either of the above
named negroes what I have given to my Grand Children shall do that one out of my
estate shall be put in the place of the one that dies so that all my Grand Children ^{shall} have
equal Legacy - My further Will and desire is that after the death of my beloved
Wife all my estate except negroes shall be sold at three years credit and the money
arising from such sale together with all the negroes in my estate to be equally divided
among all my living Grand Children or their heirs and each Legacy in negroes to be
hired out for the support of the owner until each comes of age or marries - and I do
hereby constitute and appoint my beloved Wife Susannah Sandefur Executor and Richard
Davenport Senr Morris Sumner William Garner Grief Backhouse and John Madisons execu-
tors of this my Last Will and Testament annulling and revoking all others heretofore made
by me As Witness my hand and Seal this twenty second day of September eighteen
hundred and thirty six
