At a Court held for Charlotte County the 5th day of July 1802

This Last Will and Testament of John Thomas dec^d was presented in Court by John Thomas one of the executors herein named and the same was proved by the oath of William McKinney, George Harroway, and Francis Scott Jur^{ts} the Subscribing Witnesses and ordered to be recorded. On the motion of the said executor who made oath according to Law Certificate is Granted him for obtaining a final order of the said Will in due form the giving Security whereupon he with Thomas Gaines his Security entered into and acknowledged their bonds according to Law for that purpose, and Joel Matthews the other executor named in this Will renounced in open Court the burthen of the execution of the said Will.
