my last Will and Testament that is to say I commend my soul into the hands of Almighty
God that gave it and ~~body~~ ^{my} to the rest to be buried in a decent manner, and as touching my
worldly estate where with it hath Pleased almighty god to bless me with, I tem I give in the
following manner that is to say: First — I tem I give and bequeath to my grand son
John Madison son of Henry Madison one Negro boy named Bob, to him and his heirs
forever; I tem I give to John White of William White one negro boy Abram to him and his
heirs forever; I tem I give to Mary Grigg daughter of James Grigg (my grand daughter) one
Negro girl named Mary to her and her heirs forever; I tem I give to Charles Williamson (my
grand son) son of Calhoun Williamson one Negro girl named Melly to him and his heirs
forever; I tem I give to my beloved son William White one Negro Girl named Sarah to
him and his heirs forever; I tem I give to my beloved son Mathew White one Negro boy named
Saul also one Negro Girl named Nancy to him and his heirs forever; I tem I give to my
well beloved son Daniel White one Negro boy named Bartlet also one Negro Girl named
Beth to him and his heirs forever; I tem I give unto my beloved Daughters Sarah White one
Negro woman named Jane also one Negro woman named Hannah to her and her heirs forever;
I tem I lend to my beloved wife Mary White during her natural life one Negro man named
Dick also one negroman named Yellow dick also one Negro wench named Agg, also one
Negro wench named Lucy, I tem I lend to my beloved wife Mary White the

Negro Girl named Mary to her and her heirs forever; Item I give to Charles Williamson (my
grand son) son of Bathurst Williamson one Negro girl named Melly to her and her heirs
forever; Item I give to my beloved son William White one Negro Girl named Sarah to
him and his heirs forever, Item I give to my beloved son Mathew White one Negro boy named
Saul also one Negro Girl named Nancy to him and his heirs forever, Item I give to my
well beloved son Daniel White one Negro boy named Bartlet also one Negro Girl named
Beth to him and his heirs forever; Item I give unto my beloved Daughter Sarah White one
Negro woman named Jane also one Negro woman named Hannah to her and her heirs forever;
Item I lend to my beloved wife Mary White during her natural life one Negro man named
Dick also one negwoman named Yellow dick also one Negro wench named Agg, also one
Negro wench named Lucy, Item I lend to my beloved wife Mary White the use of my
Water Lyeist Mill with all the Necessaries thereto with all profits that may arise from the
same until the rendering her Natural life, Item I give to my well beloved son Daniel
White, after the decease of my beloved wife Mary White the above mentioned Lyeist Mill
to him and his heirs forever, Item I give to my beloved son Daniel White the tract of
Land lying on Rough & Crab Creek it being divided from the tract whereon I now live
by a New line beginning on Crab Creek at a poplar thence the upper side of an old
field near Daniel Whites house thence to the Hill branch including a Spring thence
to the Road as W^m, James, & Mathew Whites, Russell and James Brown witnesses do
him and his heirs forever, Item I give to my beloved son Mathew White the tract of

Land whereon I now live lying on Cub Creek with all improvements thereon to him and his heirs forever, Item I give to my well beloved son William White one tract of Land lying on the north side of Cub Creek, also a small tract adjoining the said William bounded by a branch leading to Mandolpha Lane containing fifty acres be the same more or less to him and his heirs forever, My desire is that the within mentioned slaves and their increase namely Dick, Yellow Dick, Agg. and Luer so lent to my beloved wife be equally divided at her decease between my daughters namely, Martha Madison, Mary Hakeshaw, Susanna Williamson and Sarah White to them and their heirs forever; Item I give to my beloved daughter Sarah White one horse and saddle and bridle together with George Bellus to her and her heirs forever; my desire is that the Household furniture and Stock be disposed of by my beloved wife during her natural life; Item I then give what of these may remain to my beloved son Matthew White ^{his heirs} forever; my desire is that all debts due me may be collected by my Executors, and kept by them for discharging my debts & for the use of the Estate, my desire is that there should be no Inventory or Settlement made of my Estate; I do appoint William White, Daniel White, Matthew White and Samuel White be my whole Executors, and I do hereby disannul all former Wills and Legacies to be Void and of none effect, as ~~Witness~~ my hand this twenty second day of March 1782.

At a Court held for Charlotte County the 1st day of November 1782.

The foregoing Last Will and Testament of John White dec^d with the Codicil
was presented in Court by William White, Daniel White, Matthew White
Samuel White the Executors therein named, and the Will was proved by the
oaths of William Price, & Thomas North, and the Codicil by the oath of Martin
Baker, and ordered to be Recorded. On the Motion of the said Executors
who made oath according to Law, Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of
the said Will, they giving security whereupon they with Martin Baker and
William Price their ^{Securities} entered into and acknowledged their bond for that purpose
