with. I give and bequeath in manner and form following. I Now I give and bequeath to my
daughter Peggy (to have one negroe Girl Milley to her and her heirs forever. I then I give to my
Daughter Patsy one negroe Girl Jincy and one cow and calf to her and her heirs forever. I then
I give to my Daughter Molly one Negroe Girl, Anaca and one cow and calf to her and her heirs
I then I send to my beloved Wife Susannah the my negroe man named Cain and my negroe
Woman named Sam with their future Increase, also my tract of Land I now live on with
all my Stock of horses & cows Sheep and hogs during her widowhood with all my household
and Kitchen furniture and plantation Utensils and at ^{the death} or marriage my desire is that my Land
be Sold and the money arising therefrom with all the rest of my Estate lent to my wife be equally
divided among my five Children, William, Lucy, Siddy, Lemmy, and John by my Executors
Lastly I constitute and appoint my loving Wife my Executors and my Friends John Burt
my Executor of this my last will and Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto affixed
my hand and seal this 1st day of September 1780. Joel Stow L. S.
